### Research

## Who makes this happen?



These designers design and make the outfits worn in Carnival. They can also tailor-make costumes based on designs from samba schools. Many of these designers started out making costumes at home before their talent was noticed.

Designer

#### Carnival Designer/ Carnavalesco

Dictates the Carnival's overall vision and samba parade events. They decide on the theme of the carnival and are also in charge of everything including costume ideas, float ornaments, predominant songs etc.

## Wing President

Each wing of the carnival has its own president, who are responsible for their wing's costume design and production/purchase in time for the event. They also supervise the precise dance technique.
